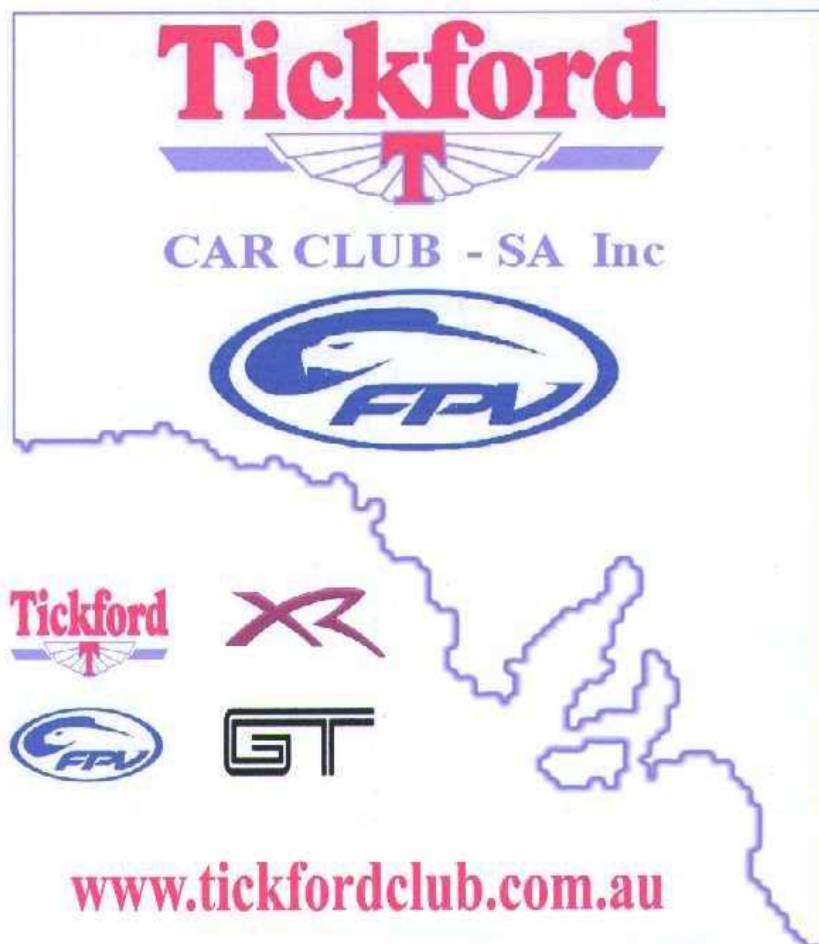

### NEW PROPOSAL FOR ALLOCATING TICKETS CLIPSAL 500

One subject that has caused much debate between the club members and committee is the allocation of tickets for the Clipsal 500. Unfortunately, the amount of tickets given to the THREE "XR" clubs is beyond our control – they come from FORD.

All we can do is find some way of fairly allocating what tickets we end up with. Firstly, the Committee agrees that these tickets should reward PARTICIPATION within the club over a calendar year, all meetings and events attended will count towards each members tally. The selection process will be by points gained during the year and the availability of club member with a club car for the entire 4 days. If a person joins half way through the year and attends every event and meeting, his points will be void and will officially start on the first day of January in the the new year. (just to keep it fair to existing members)

It is proposed that:

1. The selection will be done at the FIRST meeting in January
2. 20 club members with the highest tallies will be selected and reduced to the correct numbers when the total of tickets is known.
3. The club members selected will have to attend for all FOUR days.
4. The club members will need to have club cars and need to be on display in a clean state every day, engine displays are optional.
5. The club members attending will help set-up and pack-up every day.
6. The club members will take turns to watch the vehicles (a roster will be made up – Including during the races)

## ROADTRIP TO BATHURST – OCT 2005

Steve (Howie) has asked me to put this in; I have also emailed it out;

**Super Cheap Auto - Bathurst 1000** - Following the Mt Gambier Show and Shine Randall, Adrian and I (and partners) are intending to travel from Mt Gambier to Bathurst for the Super Cheap Auto Bathurst 1000 (note the change in sponsor this year) the following weekend. This is NOT an official club run but more a open invitation for those who may wish to join us on the trip that looks like becoming a yearly sojourn (this will be Deb's and my third year). The current DRAFT plan is to travel to Bathurst from Mt Gambier via Melbourne and the Princes Highway. At this stage we are planning on a four day trip which will look something like this:

\* Day 1 Mon 3 Oct 05 - Mt Gambier to Melbourne (somewhere between Hallam and Pakenham) This is probably a six hour run arriving in the afternoon. Nothing planned. Some might like to travel into the city to Southbank for dinner/casino or to a local pub/restaurant; individual choice.

\* Day 2 Tue 4 Oct 05 - Melbourne to Lakes Entrance Estimate a six hour drive plus stops for a bit of sightseeing. Probably a reasonably early start to allow for the sightseeing stuff.

\* Day 3 Wed 5 Oct 05 - Lakes Entrance to Batemans Bay Probably about five to six hours driving plus tourists stops. Again a reasonably early start to allow for the sticky beaking stuff.

\* Day 4 Thur 6 Oct 05 - Batemans Bay to Orange. This is a longer day at about ten hours run with no sightseeing. Just a pleasant drive through the NSW country side via Canberra, Yass, Boorowa and Cowra then on to the Bathurst/Orange area depending on where your accommodation is.

We will advise (in the near future) where we intend to stay for each overnight stop but it will be up to individuals to book their own accommodation at or near the overnight location. Be aware that Bathurst/Orange area accommodation is at a premium for the race weekend so early booking (like right now) is well advised. Also, NSW will still be on school holidays and accommodation may also be at a premium in NSW and Lakes Entrance; so again suggest overnight bookings be made sooner rather than later.

It will be up to individuals to buy their tickets to the race although there is some prospect that we may be able to get general admission tickets at a discount; we will advise as this becomes known. If you want grand stand tickets then suggest you book then sooner than later. If you are happy with general admission they you can hang off until we know where we stand re the discounted ones. Depending on how things pan out there may also be an opportunity to display the vehicles in conjunction with our NSW sister club.

There are a couple of options for the return leg after the race on Sun 9 Oct. Some may want to bolt straight from the race (fiveish to sixish) and stay somewhere like West Wyalong (about a three to four hour drive; trying to get any further will have you driving on the Hay Plan at night; watch out for those giant hopping mice) and drive through to Adelaide (about a 14 hours) on Monday. The other option is to stay in the Bathurst/Orange area Sunday night and spend one (about 18 hours) or two days (a more leisurely experience probably staying in Mildura or Renmark) driving back. Again we leave the return travel plans up to the individual.

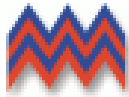
